BootCamp for New Nonprofit CEOs August 3–5, 2016 at North Park University

Leading an organization, engaging stakeholders, raising funds and managing staff can be a challenge. Attending BootCamp allows you to invest in yourself as a leader for three eye-opening days of professional growth. Hear from expert speakers on topics ranging from fundraising, board management and strategic planning to human resources and project management. Connect with other nonprofit executive directors from across a variety of subsectors for support and collaborative solutions to the challenges you wrestle with in your leadership role.

The BootCamp is being offered by the Axelson Center for Nonprofit Management. This year's application is available at www.northpark.edu/bootcamp and the deadline to apply is July 15, 2016. Participants should have 3 years or less experience as a nonprofit ED/CEO. The total 2016 program cost is \$795; a \$200 scholarship is available for organizations with an annual budget less than \$1 million.
